

CLINTON COUNTY AG SOCIETY CLASS:
8000 Work Stock Diesel 4 x 4 Trucks

RULES – Clinton County Fairgrounds – Saturday, September 23, 2017

1. Must meet all general rules.
2. Must meet full safety requirements.
3. All vehicles must have a current license plate in place and current registration.
4. All drivers must wear a seatbelt.
5. 8000 lbs weight limit.
6. Weight brackets or hanging weights can be used. No weight boxes allowed. Weights must be securely fastened. (Weights falling off will be a DQ).
7. Hitch must extend beyond the rear of the truck and easily accessible for person hooking to the sled. The hitch must be a receiver style hitch, no closer than 44" from the centerline of the axle and no part of the hitch can exceed past the centerline of the axle forward.
8. Puller must provide his/her own hitch with a minimum opening of 3 ¾" opening.
9. No pintle type hitches, chain hitches, ball hitches or any other device pulling from rear end housing.
10. Hitch must be rigid in all directions, except for horizontal clevis.
11. Maximum hitch height is 26".
12. DOT street tires only.
13. No studded, cuts, or modified tires allowed.
14. Factory dual wheels are permitted on a factory dually.
15. Diesel fuel only.
16. All exhaust must exit behind the cab.
17. Body of the truck must be complete with all glass in place.
18. Vehicle must have a bed in place.
19. Flatbeds are permitted, but must have floor in place to cover rear wheels.
20. Stock one ton driveline or less.
21. Trucks must have complete suspension in factory location. Rear can be solid as long as it's not welded in.
22. All traction/rearend bars must be forward of the rear axle.
23. All brakes must be in place and in working order.
24. Turbo charges must be stock appearing. One ton or smaller. No S400.
25. This is a work stock class. No 2.5 trucks allowed, no dual CP3's.
26. The top trucks will be teched.
27. No ag governors.
