

# DEPARTMENT 4 - CAMPING

## FEES AND RULES

*If you are interested in a campsite at the fair, please contact the fair office and asked to be placed on the list.*

**FEES:**

- Electric and Water                    \$200.00
- Lot (No Electric or Water)        \$125.00
- Parking                                Each campsite will include on reserved car parking permit in a designated area. Additional parking permits can be purchased at \$25.00 each

**INFORMATION & RULES:**

- You may begin to pick-up your parking and camping permits on June 25th. The fair office will be open from 8:00am to 4:00pm.
- When you arrive at the fair with your camper, you must sign in at the office with contract information for the person camping in the spot.
- All occupants of campers must have a Season Pass, Membership Pass, Jr. Fair Pass, or Exhibitors Pass.
- Campers may not park until 8:00am on Sunday, July 1, 2018.
- Electric will be turned on Friday, July 6th and turned off on Sunday, July 15th. Anyone using electric prior to Friday, July 6th will pay \$30.00/day.
- Campers are not permitted to leave the grounds until the last day of the fair after midnight.
- All campsites must be occupied by a camper or tent, and the owner of the site is liable for any damage to electrical or water outlets.
- A 30 amp (camper plug) service will be provided for each hook-up. Use 10 gauge grounded wire for hook-up.
- One adult must be present at the campsite during quite time 11:00pm to 6:00am.
- Alcohol will not be permitted outside of the camper. If minors are found using or possession drugs or alcohol, law enforcement will be contacted, and camping privileges will be lost.
- No sewage or waste water may be discharged on the lots in the camping areas. Pumping services will be on-site during the fair at your cost. After the conclusion of the fair, the dump site located at the north end of the grounds can be utilized to release your waste water and sewage. Anyone found dumping waste or sewage will lose camping privileges and will be responsible for clean-up fees.
- All camping permits and parking permits must be visibly displayed in the window.
- Lot size is 18 ft. x 30 ft. Arrangements must be made with the camping committee for campers longer than 30 ft. Also, primitive camping spots are 18 ft. x 30 ft. with no water or electric supplied. All generators must be shut off between 10:00pm and 8:00am. Lots will be marked with a stake and number in the center of the lot.
- The camping committee will rule on any questions not specifically covered in the rules. The Clinton County Agricultural Society reserves the right to cancel a lot contract at any time or servers the right to reject any application for camping and will not be held responsible for accidents of any sort.
