Entries close on Friday, June 29, 2018 at 4:00pm

Entries are open to residents inside and outside of Clinton County.

Please write name on the back of claim ticket as this helps expedite the release process.

All exhibitors must purchase a season pass or membership ticket. Youth exhibitors must purchase a season pass unless they possess a Junior Fair wristband.

An entry fee of \$1.00 will also be charged per entry.

You may enter as many classes as you would like, but no more than 2 entries will be permitted by any one exhibitor in any one class except where otherwise stated.

Classes with large numbers of entries will be broken into smaller classes to provide more premiums.

The exhibitor should plan to provide all display plates and materials.

The Produce Exhibit will be closed to exhibitors and spectators during judging.

The Clinton County Agricultural Society and committees are not responsible for loss or damage, nor not responsible for items not picked-up by release time.

Arrive: Tuesday, July 10, 2018 from 9:00 am to 12:00pm

Judging: Tuesday, July 10, 2018 at 1:00pm

Released: Saturday, July 14, 2018 at 4:00pm all items must be claimed by 5:30pm. No early releases.

Farm Grain & Crops / Grains & Seeds

All grains and seeds to be grown in 2017 except those which mature and are harvested before the Fair in 2018.

Farm Grain & Crops / Display

Class 01 – Display of Farm Grain & Crops – Display of at least 3 of the classes listed in Division 1 / Sections 1, 2 & 3. Judging based on 50% display and 50% quality. If you enter this class and another class, you will need 2 samples to display.

Vegetables / Display

Class 01 – General Garden Display – To be set on your own card table. Display may include flowers, vegetables, and fruits. Will be judged 1/3 on number of different items, 1/3 on number of different items, and 1/3 on artistic arrangement.

Class 02 – Mixed Vegetable Display – Must contain at least 10 different vegetables displayed in a decorated basket. Each exhibitor will need to furnish their own basket. Judging will be based 1/3 on artistic arrangement, 1/3 on quality of vegetables, and 1/3 on number of different vegetables.

Gourds / Display

Class 01 – Gourds Best Display – Display of 6 or more different varieties arranged in a tray, bowl, or basket.

Honey

All apiary products must be produced by the exhibitor in his/her own apiary.

Honey must be displayed in 1-lb glass jars with no labels.

Honey to be judged on quality, cleanliness, and aroma.

Exhibitor is limited to 2 entries in each class.

Cut Comb Honey should be displayed in clear plastic containers.
