#### **Department 7 – General Information:**

Entries close on Friday, June 29, 2018 at 4:00pm  
Entries are open to residents outside of Clinton County.

All exhibitors must purchase a season pass or membership ticket. Youth exhibitors must purchase a season pass unless they possess a Junior Fair wristband. Youth must be assigned an exhibitor number.

An entry fee of \$1.00 will also be charged per entry for both Adult and Youth entries.

You may enter as many classes as you would like, but only one entry per exhibitor per class.

Judging will be open and questions may be asked at the end of the judging based on judges availability.

The judge shall withhold premium of the entry if not worthy of an award.

All judging is not final until one hour after all items have been judged.

The Clinton County Agricultural Society and committees are not responsible for loss or damage, nor responsible for items not picked-up by release time.

Arrive: Saturday, July 7, 2018 from 8:00am to 12:00pm  
Judging: Monday, July 9, 2018 at 10:00am  
Released: Saturday, July 14, 2018 at 4:00pm all items must be claimed by 5:30pm. No early releases.

#### **Needlecrafts & Handcrafts**

Do not bring two of the same item unless guidelines of the class request more than one or pairs.  
No soiled or damaged entries will be considered.

#### **Needlecrafts / Crochet**

Enter Afghan in the class where the most work was completed.

#### **Needlecrafts / Counted Cross Stitch**

Frame does not count on size.  
All pictures must have wire, bracket, etc.  
No stand-up frames.  
Plastic canvas only acceptable in Section 7.

#### **Handcrafts**

No pedestals.

#### **Canned Goods**

Due to earlier fair date, items canned during the 2017 season will be eligible to be entered in the 2018 Fair.  
Pint or Quart size.  
No freezer items.  
No commercial items.  
Specimen classes, please list name and type.

**Baked Goods**

No commercial mix.  
 Pan or container size does not count towards judging.  
 Tea towel, napkin, or breadbasket not required.

**Decorated Cakes and Decorated Cup Cakes** – may use dummy form, will not be cut.

**Cakes** – glassware is not preferred, and if you bring glassware, the Fair Committee is not responsible for breakage or loss.

**Cookies** – 3 cookies on a 6" foam or paper plate. No glassware, baskets, or containers.

**Breads** – plate only, no basket or container.

**Candy** – 3 pieces on a foam or paper plate.

**Miscellaneous** – Use plastic bag.

**Baked Goods Auction** - All first and second placed Baked Good Entries are required to be donated to the Baked Goods Auction. Bakers who donate their baked goods to be auctioned will receive 50% of the sale proceeds of their baked good.

The auction will consist of Cakes (non-decorated classes), Cookies, Yeast Bread, Quick Bread, and Pie sections. Cupcakes, Cookies, and Brownies – minimum of 12 on a disposable plate, covered.  
 Rolls – minimum of 6 on a disposable plate, covered.
